Since 1980, the Trust has contributed to the ever escalating cost of repairs to churches of all denominations. To date, it has been able to make grants totalling over £1,100,000 to 352 churches and chapels. The need for our help continues to grow, however, and we are entirely dependent on support from private individuals, business concerns and all others in sympathy with our aims.

We aim to raise funds in diverse ways; for example, the Trust holds an annual Bike Ride which raised over £42,000 in 2006. Of this, half was retained by the churches and chapels which provided the participants. In recent years, polo matches - in which our patron, HRH The Prince of Wales, played - have also made a major contribution. Further funds have come from concerts in several splendid churches and other venues in the county. These events, together with the donations, legacies and gifts in memoriam for which the Trust is most grateful, enabled grants of £105,000 to be given to 37 churches of various denominations in 2006.

The origins of the Choir date back to 1970. It is made up from serving and retired members of the regular Force and Special Constabulary, together with support staff and other invited guests.

The Choir, which consists of more than 60 choristers, has performed extensively throughout the United Kingdom and has undertaken tours of California, Germany and Jersey.

Venues have included the Royal Festival Hall, the Royal Albert Hall, Birmingham Symphony Hall and the Colston Hall, Bristol, and audiences have included members of the Royal Family. The Choir has also sung in various cathedrals including Bristol, Gloucester, Liverpool, Llandaff, Worcester, Salisbury and York Minster.

The Choir has made three recordings on its own in 1984, 1988 and 1997 as well as joint recordings with a number of other choirs. A new recording was released in December 2006.
